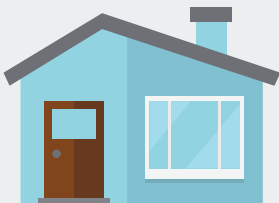

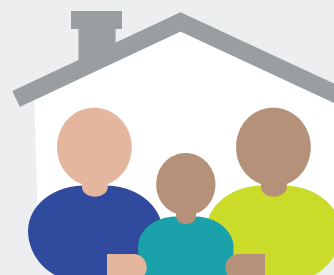

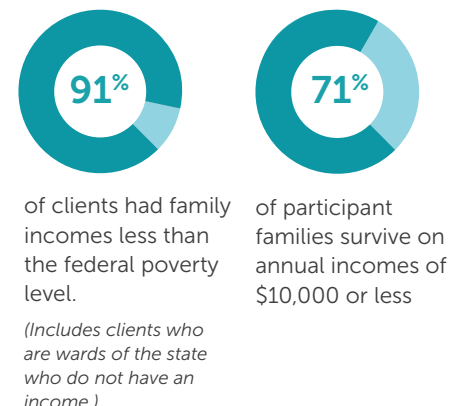

FAMILY INCOME*



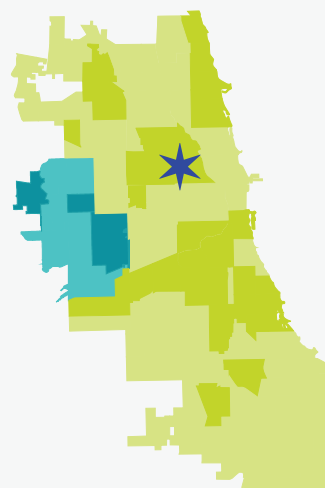
