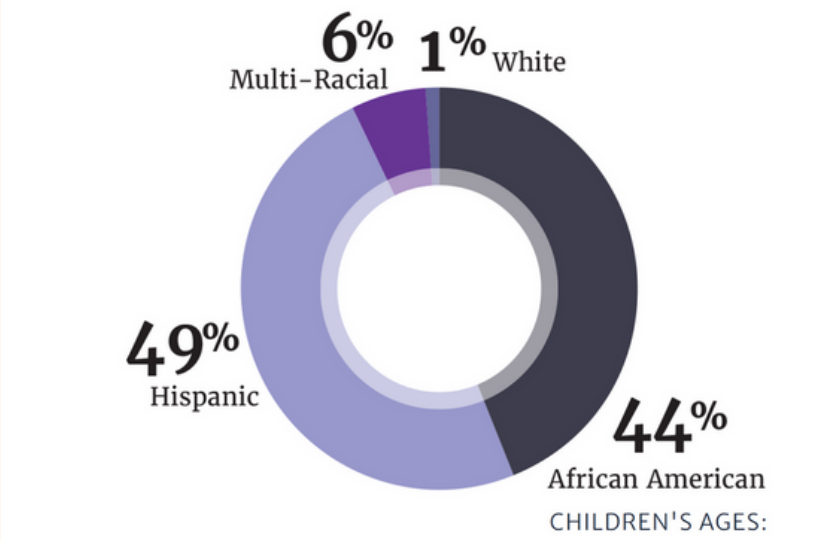

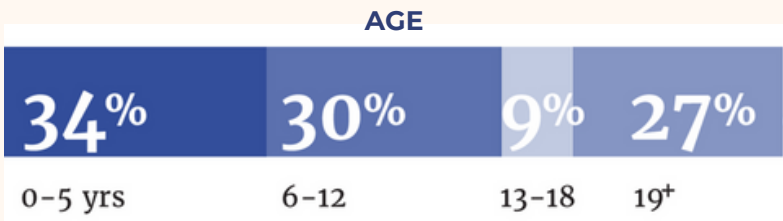

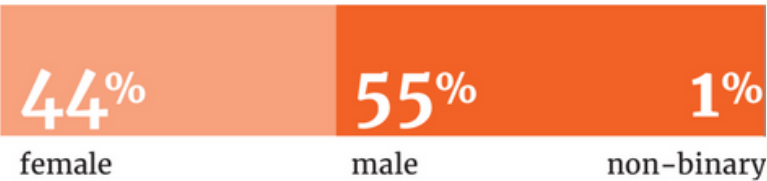
RACE/ETHNICITY



CHILDREN'S AGES:



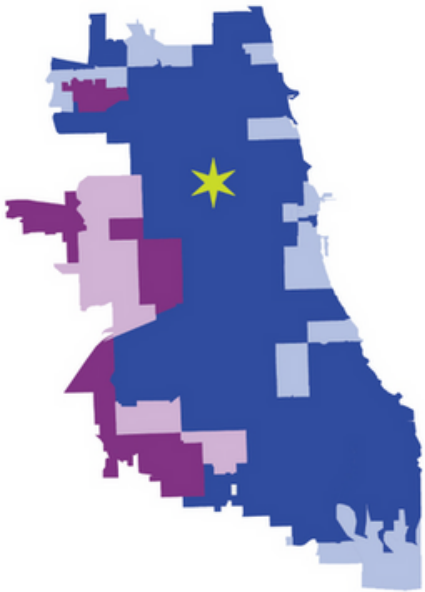
GENDER
